Aim / Educational Purpose

Children explore native wildlife and develop environmental awareness, inquiry skills, respectful engagement practices and confidence in community learning environments. The excursion supports EYLF learning outcomes relating to connection with the natural world, wellbeing and communication.

Proposed Activities

- Guided wildlife observation focusing on animal habitats, safety awareness and respectful behaviour
- Observation of native animals, enclosures and habitat features
- Environmental discussions about native species, ecosystems and conservation
- Reinforcement of safety boundaries around enclosures and controlled areas
- Group reflection and communication activities encouraging vocabulary development
- Picnic routines and hygiene practices in designated safe areas
- Hydration monitoring and rest breaks in shaded areas

The excursion will be cancelled, postponed or modified if environmental conditions are deemed unsafe, including extreme heat, storms or severe weather warnings.

All children will be secured in approved, age-appropriate restraints in accordance with Northern Territory road safety legislation and Regulation 100 of the Education and Care Services National Regulations. Vehicle restraints are inspected by Kids Safe NT and documentation is maintained on file.
